Scheduled Activities:

Grade III & IV - CREATIVE CIRCLE : CONSTRUCTION OF FAMILY TREE

Skills Developed:

- o Understanding Relationships: Students will learn about family dynamics and connections.
- Research Skills: Gathering information about family members fosters investigative skills.
- o Creativity: Designing the family tree encourages artistic expression.
- Communication: Sharing family stories enhances verbal skills.

Grade V & VI: MASK MAKING AND CHARACTER WRITE-UP

Skills Developed:

- Fine Motor Skills: Working with materials for mask making improves dexterity.
- Creativity and Imagination: Designing masks of favorite characters nurtures creativity.
- Critical Thinking: Writing about the character requires observation and analytical skills.

- Nutritional Knowledge: Understanding food groups, Recognizing healthy versus unhealthy choices, Importance of a balanced diet
- Cultural Awareness: Appreciation for global cuisines, Understanding cultural traditions related to food, Respect for diverse eating practices
- Creativity: Experimenting with flavors and textures, Creating unique dishes, Engaging in food presentation
- Sensory Awareness: Exploring different tastes, smells, and textures, Developing a palate for diverse flavors, Mindful eating practices
