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### **Pass Criteria and Compartment Eligibility for Grade XI**

Dear Parents,

As we approach the end of the academic session, we wish to provide clarity regarding the promotion policy for Grade XI students. To ensure a smooth transition to Grade XII and to maintain high academic standards, the following criteria will be strictly implemented for the 2025-2026 Annual Examinations.

#### **I. Passing Criteria for Grade XI**

Promotion to Grade XII is determined by the student's performance in the Annual Examination. To be declared "Pass," a student must fulfill the following requirements:

- **Subject-Wise Proficiency:** Secure a minimum of **33% marks** in each subject.  
*Note:* For subjects with practical components, students must secure **33% in Theory and 33% in Practical separately** to pass the subject.
- **School Standards:** Meet the overall aggregate passing requirements as prescribed by the school's academic board.
- **Attendance Norms:** Fulfill the mandatory attendance requirement as per school and board norms. Failure to meet the required percentage may result in the student being debarred from the examination.

#### **II. Eligibility for Compartment in Grade XI Examination**

In case, a student does not meet the passing criteria in the Annual Examination, the following rules regarding "**Compartment**" and "**Detained**" will apply:

- Fails in **one (1) out of the five** main subjects
  - Eligible to sit for a re-examination (Compartment) in that specific subject, provided all Internal Assessments are cleared.
- Fails in **two (2) or more** main subjects.
  - The student will be declared "**Detained**" and must repeat Grade XI to strengthen their foundational knowledge.

**Important Note on Internal Assessment:** A student is only eligible for a Compartment Examination if they have successfully qualified in all subjects of the **Internal Assessment**.

We urge parents to review these guidelines with their wards to ensure they remain focused on their academic goals. Our faculty remains available to support any student requiring additional guidance during this revision period.
