Keeping this in mind, we are going to organize a hindi story telling competition in Upper Kindergarten to help children develop a liking towards hindi, overcome their stage fright, increase verbal proficiency and enhance the listening skills.

The competition is scheduled on Sunday 02 November 2025.

The Hindi teacher will send three audio files narrating the story via WhatsApp. The students can choose from any one of the three stories sent. The titles of the stories are as follows:

The contestants will be judged on the basis of the following points:

- Introduction and confidence.
- Presentation (action and expressions).

The children can narrate the story in the way it has been taught by the parents.

Note: The story should be in Hindi and each student will be given a maximum time of 5 minutes to narrate the story.
