Subject: Revised Academic Schedule and Special Academic Support Programme for Grades IX–XII

Dear Parents and Students,

Greetings from the School.

In view of the extension of the summer vacation, the total number of instructional days available for the current academic session has been reduced. To ensure that our students receive the required academic engagement and learning opportunities, the school has revised certain dates in the academic calendar.

The period originally designated as **Non-Instructional Days from 24 June 2026 to 1 July 2026**, as mentioned in the School Diary, will now be treated as **Regular Instructional Days**. Therefore, all students of **Grades IX to XII** are required to attend school regularly after the completion of the Term Examinations until **1 July 2026**. **2 July 2026** will be observed as the **Report Card Distribution Day**.

Based on the analysis of student performance in **PT-I**, selected students of **Grades X and XII** will be required to attend special academic support classes on **10, 13, 15, 17, 20, and 22 June 2026**. Individual communication regarding the selected students will be shared separately. These classes are intended to provide focused academic support and strengthen preparation for the forthcoming examinations.

Students of **Grades IX and XI** are advised to prepare seriously for the examinations and demonstrate their academic potential. Students whose performance is found to be below the expected standard may also be included in future academic support programmes.

The school will function with **regular school timings on all examination days**. Prior to the examination, students will be engaged in intensive study and revision sessions under the guidance of their teachers.

Examination Schedule:

- Question Paper Reading Time: 9:30 a.m. – 9:45 a.m.
- Examination Time: 9:45 a.m. – 12:45 p.m.
- Dispersal: As per the regular school schedule.



Students are required to report to school at the regular reporting time. Students arriving only for the examination will not be permitted, as the pre-examination study sessions form an integral part of the school's academic programme.
