Mental Maths:

Our School is organizing Mental Maths Abacus Classes to improve the Mathematical Skill. UCMAS Abacus is organizing the class every year and 50 students getting trained. Last Batch 42 students successfully completed the levels of exam.

Orientation programme for Secondary and Sr. Secondary Students:

The orientation programme for grades X and XII of the session 2019-29 for boys and girls was conducted in March 2019 where students were briefed about the curriculum and academic plans for new session were discussed by Principal and HODs of different subjects.

Orientation programme for teachers:

Training and mentoring is the benchmark of professional growth and it facilitates effective teaching by focusing on the wide range of aspects that would influence the teaching learning experience.

To develop a conducive environment in the school for the healthy growth of the staff, a workshop on "Fostering Positive Culture" was conducted on 11 March 2019.
